17	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
18	Section 1. Sections 31-9-80 and 31-9-81, Code of
19	Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:
20	"§31-9-80.
21	"As used in this article, the following terms shall
22	have the following meanings:
23	"(1) COMMITTEE. The Alabama Disaster Recovery
24	Program Committee.
25	"(2) RECOVERY FUND. The Alabama Disaster Recovery
26	Fund.

"(3) RECOVERY PROGRAM. The Alabama Disaster Recovery
 Program.

## 3 "(4) SYSTEM. The Statewide Emergency Notification 4 System authorized in the act adding this amendatory language. 5 "\$31-9-81.

"There is hereby created the Alabama Disaster 6 7 Recovery Program for the purpose purposes of providing financial assistance to eligible counties and municipalities 8 for meeting local needs before, during, and immediately 9 10 following a disaster that affects a county or municipality. and of establishing, implementing, operating, and maintaining 11 the Statewide Emergency Notification System to facilitate 12 13 statewide communication of emergency responses, decisions, and 14 warnings of developing emergency situations for the benefit of 15 residents and state and local emergency management agencies. The recovery program shall be funded by the Alabama Disaster 16 17 Recovery Fund. The Legislature may make appropriations to the 18 recovery fund from State General Fund revenues, available federal monies, revenues made available by future legislative 19 20 acts, or from any other source available except insurance 21 policy surcharges. All revenues appropriated to the recovery 22 fund shall be paid to the Emergency Management Agency and 23 deposited into a separate fund account. All revenues paid into 24 the recovery fund shall remain in the recovery fund until such 25 time as expended as provided in this article, and shall not 26 revert to the State General Fund or be expended for any 27 purposes other than those set out in this article. All

revenues appropriated to the recovery fund, except those funds 1 appropriated pursuant to Section 31-9-87, shall be paid to the 2 3 Emergency Management Agency and deposited into a separate fund. Distribution of funds, except those funds appropriated 4 pursuant to Section 31-9-87, shall be made to eligible 5 counties and municipalities pursuant to procedures established 6 7 by the Emergency Management Agency in accordance with this 8 article. The recovery fund revenues shall be expended for 9 purposes set out in Section 31-9-83. All revenues appropriated 10 to the recovery fund pursuant to Section 31-9-87 shall be paid to the Emergency Management Agency and deposited into a 11 separate fund which shall be known as the Alabama Statewide 12 13 Emergency Notification System Fund and shall be expended only as provided in Section 31-9-87." 14 15 Section 2. Section 31-9-87 is added to the Code of 16 Alabama 1975, to read as follows: §31-9-87. 17 18 (a) Funds shall be appropriated by the Legislature to the Alabama Statewide Emergency Notification System Fund 19 20 within the recovery fund for the purposes of establishing, 21 implementing, maintaining, and operating the system, and, 22 thereafter, shall be appropriated annually by the Legislature

for continuous maintenance and operation of the system. Funding for the system may also be derived from gifts, federal grants, other appropriations from the Legislature, fees and contributions from users, or any other sources permitted by law. Any disbursement from the Alabama Statewide Emergency

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Notification System Fund shall be authorized in advance by the
 committee.

3 (b) Within three months after the Legislature
4 appropriates funds for the system, the committee and the State
5 Emergency Management Agency shall jointly develop requirements
6 and specifications for the system. The State Emergency
7 Management Agency shall provide administrative and technical
8 assistance to the committee.

9 (c) Any procurement paid in whole or in part with 10 funds from the Alabama Statewide Emergency Notification System 11 Fund shall comply with Article 2, Chapter 16, Title 41, or 12 other law, as applicable.

(d) The State Emergency Management Agency shall
serve as the awarding authority for any procurement paid in
whole or in part with funds from the Alabama Statewide
Emergency Notification System Fund and upon recommendation of
the committee, may purchase, lease, acquire, or otherwise
implement the system to serve citizens and state and local
emergency management agencies.

20 (e) The committee shall submit an annual report to 21 the Governor, Lieutenant Governor, President Pro Tempore of 22 the Senate, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the 23 Senate Minority Leader, and the House Minority Leader 24 detailing all expenditures in the previous fiscal year, the 25 operation of the program, and its role in Alabama's overall 26 system of preparation, response, and recovery from emergency situations. 27

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Section 3. This act shall become effective
 immediately following its passage and approval by the
 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
