25	majority of the qualified electors voting thereon and in
26	accordance with Sections 284, 285, and 287 of the Constitution
27	of Alabama of 1901, as amended:

1	PROPOSED AMENDMENT
2	(a) The following term shall have the following
3	meaning:
4	(1) VIRTUAL CURRENCY. A digital representation of
5	value, other than a representation of the United State dollar

6 or a foreign currency, that functions as a unit of account, a 7 store of value, and/or a medium of exchange.

8 (b) Virtual currency shall be exempt from state,
9 county, and local ad valorem taxation.

10 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 11 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 12 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 13 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 14 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this 15 state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the following description of the substance or subject matter of the proposed constitutional amendment:
