10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT

13 Relating to Greene County; to authorize the Greene
14 County Commission to provide for the compensation and expense
15 allowances of the coroner including expenses for the operation
16 of the office of coroner; and to repeal Section 45-32-60.01 of
17 the Code of Alabama 1975.

18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

19 Section 1. (a) In Greene County, the Greene County
20 Commission may provide the Coroner of Greene County with
21 additional expense allowances and compensation or salary. The
22 county commission may provide for any expense allowance
23 granted to the coroner by this act or otherwise to convert to
24 salary effective beginning the next term of office of the
25 coroner. Any salary otherwise granted to the coroner shall be
26 effective beginning the next term of office of the coroner. In
27 addition, the coroner shall be entitled to receive any uniform

1 increases in compensation granted to other local elected
2 officials pursuant to Chapter 2A of Title 11 of the Code of
3 Alabama 1975, except that any increases in compensation during
4 the term of the coroner shall be paid as an expense allowance
5 and shall convert to salary effective beginning the next term
6 of office of the coroner.

7 (b) The Greene County Commission may provide the
8 coroner with a mileage allowance or travel allowance or the
9 use of a county vehicle in the performance of the official
10 duties of the coroner.

11 (c) The Greene County Commission may provide the
12 coroner with equipment and supplies for the performance of the
13 duties of the coroner.

14 (d) The Greene County Commission may authorize the
15 coroner to participate in health insurance benefits in the
16 same manner as county employees and may provide the coroner
17 with a fee for each death certificate issued by the coroner.

18 (e) All compensation and allowances provided by this
19 act shall be paid out of the General Fund of Greene County.

20 (f) Acceptance by the coroner of any allowances or
21 other compensation or expenses provided pursuant to this act
22 shall be in lieu of any expenses authorized to be received by
23 the coroner pursuant to general law.

24 Section 2. On October 1 following the effective date
25 of this act, Section 45-32-60.01 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
26 relating to fees for death certificates and mileage allowances
27 for the coroner, is repealed.

1 Section 3. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
