2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Greene County; to authorize the Greene
4 County Commission to provide for the compensation and expense
5 allowances of the coroner including expenses for the operation
6 of the office of coroner; and to repeal Section 45-32-60.01 of
7 the Code of Alabama 1975.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. (a) In Greene County, the Greene County
10 Commission may provide the Coroner of Greene County with
11 additional expense allowances and compensation or salary. The
12 county commission may provide for any expense allowance
13 granted to the coroner by this act or otherwise to convert to
14 salary effective beginning the next term of office of the
15 coroner. Any salary otherwise granted to the coroner shall be
16 effective beginning the next term of office of the coroner. In
17 addition, the coroner shall be entitled to receive any uniform
18 increases in compensation granted to other local elected
19 officials pursuant to Chapter 2A of Title 11 of the Code of
20 Alabama 1975, except that any increases in compensation during
21 the term of the coroner shall be paid as an expense allowance
22 and shall convert to salary effective beginning the next term
23 of office of the coroner.

24 (b) The Greene County Commission may provide the
25 coroner with a mileage allowance or travel allowance or the

1 use of a county vehicle in the performance of the official
2 duties of the coroner.

3 (c) The Greene County Commission may provide the
4 coroner with equipment and supplies for the performance of the
5 duties of the coroner.

6 (d) The Greene County Commission may authorize the
7 coroner to participate in health insurance benefits in the
8 same manner as county employees and may provide the coroner
9 with a fee for each death certificate issued by the coroner.

10 (e) All compensation and allowances provided by this
11 act shall be paid out of the General Fund of Greene County.

12 (f) Acceptance by the coroner of any allowances or
13 other compensation or expenses provided pursuant to this act
14 shall be in lieu of any expenses authorized to be received by
15 the coroner pursuant to general law.

16 Section 2. On October 1 following the effective date
17 of this act, Section 45-32-60.01 of the Code of Alabama 1975,
18 relating to fees for death certificates and mileage allowances
19 for the coroner, is repealed.

20 Section 3. This act shall become effective
21 immediately following its passage and approval by the
22 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
