10 TO BE ENTITLED  
11 AN ACT  
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13 Relating to Calhoun County; to provide for a special  
14 issuance fee to be collected by the License Commissioner of  
15 Calhoun County on each motor vehicle registration renewals;  
16 and to provide for the distribution of the revenue.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. In Calhoun County, a special issuance fee  
19 of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) shall be collected by the License  
20 Commissioner of Calhoun County on each motor vehicle  
21 registration renewal. The special issuance fee shall be in  
22 addition to all other fees, taxes, and other charges provided  
23 by law. The special issuance fee shall be retained by the  
24 license commissioner and may be used for the improvement of  
25 services and the operation of the office of the license  
26 commissioner and in the performance of the official duties of  
27 the license commissioner. The use of the proceeds includes,

1 but is not limited to, the preservation and storage related to  
2 motor vehicle registrations, boat registrations, business  
3 licenses, door-to-door sales, rental lease and manufactured  
4 homes, and for the purchase, installation, improvement,  
5 development, and maintenance of equipment and technology, and  
6 any other improvements or expenditures necessary for the  
7 administration of the office. The proceeds from the special  
8 issuance fee shall not be allocated for any salary or cost of  
9 living expense related to the office. The special issuance fee  
10 shall be in addition to any and all other budgeted  
11 compensation or expense provided to the license commissioner  
12 by Calhoun County.

13 Section 2. The issuance fees collected pursuant to  
14 this act shall be deposited in a segregated account in any  
15 bank in Calhoun County and may be expended at the sole  
16 discretion of the License Commissioner of Calhoun County. The  
17 expenditures of the fees shall be audited by the Department of  
18 Examiners of Public Accounts. The records of the expenditures  
19 shall be open to the public on a continuous basis. Any funds  
20 in the account not expended shall be carried over from  
21 year-to-year.

22 Section 3. This act is cumulative and shall not  
23 alter or change any existing law relating to charges and fees  
24 collected by the License Commissioner of Calhoun County.

25 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
26 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
27 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
