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2 ENROLLED, An Act,

3 Relating to Calhoun County; to provide for a special  
4 issuance fee to be collected by the License Commissioner of  
5 Calhoun County on each motor vehicle registration renewals;  
6 and to provide for the distribution of the revenue.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. In Calhoun County, a special issuance fee  
9 of twenty-five cents (\$0.25) shall be collected by the License  
10 Commissioner of Calhoun County on each motor vehicle  
11 registration renewal. The special issuance fee shall be in  
12 addition to all other fees, taxes, and other charges provided  
13 by law. The special issuance fee shall be retained by the  
14 license commissioner and may be used for the improvement of  
15 services and the operation of the office of the license  
16 commissioner and in the performance of the official duties of  
17 the license commissioner. The use of the proceeds includes,  
18 but is not limited to, the preservation and storage related to  
19 motor vehicle registrations, boat registrations, business  
20 licenses, door-to-door sales, rental lease and manufactured  
21 homes, and for the purchase, installation, improvement,  
22 development, and maintenance of equipment and technology, and  
23 any other improvements or expenditures necessary for the  
24 administration of the office. The proceeds from the special  
25 issuance fee shall not be allocated for any salary or cost of

1 living expense related to the office. The special issuance fee  
2 shall be in addition to any and all other budgeted  
3 compensation or expense provided to the license commissioner  
4 by Calhoun County.

5 Section 2. The issuance fees collected pursuant to  
6 this act shall be deposited in a segregated account in any  
7 bank in Calhoun County and may be expended at the sole  
8 discretion of the License Commissioner of Calhoun County. The  
9 expenditures of the fees shall be audited by the Department of  
10 Examiners of Public Accounts. The records of the expenditures  
11 shall be open to the public on a continuous basis. Any funds  
12 in the account not expended shall be carried over from  
13 year-to-year.

14 Section 3. This act is cumulative and shall not  
15 alter or change any existing law relating to charges and fees  
16 collected by the License Commissioner of Calhoun County.

17 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
18 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
19 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
