9 education to provide feminine hygiene products in

14 TO BE ENTITLED
15 AN ACT

17 Relating to public K-12 education; to require local
18 boards of education to provide feminine hygiene products in
19 women's bathrooms of certain schools at no cost to students.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. (a) Commencing with the 2021-2022
22 scholastic year, each local board of education shall provide,
23 in the women's restrooms of each school building under the
24 jurisdiction of the board, where any student in grades five
25 through 12 is enrolled and at no cost to students, feminine
26 hygiene products.

1 (b) For the purposes of this section, feminine
2 hygiene products include sanitary napkins and tampons.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
4 first day of the third month following its passage and
5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
