Sections 32-6-21 and 32-7-4, Code of 8 9 Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows: 10 "§32-6-21. "(a) Every applicant for an original driver license, 11 temporary instruction and learner's permit, and motor driven 12 13 cycle operator's license, shall pay an examination fee of five 14 ten dollars (\$5) (\$10) to the Alabama <del>Department of Public</del> 15 Safety State Law Enforcement Agency upon applying to the officer, state trooper, or duly authorized agent of the 16 Director of Public Safety secretary, or to one of them where 17 18 there is more than one designated by the Director of Public 19 Safety secretary. The five dollars (\$5) ten dollar (\$10) fee 20 shall be required prior to each examination. 21 "(b) The Alabama Department of Public Safety shall

21 issue proper receipts for the examination fee and shall 22 properly transmit all moneys received by it for deposit in the 23 State General Fund The fee shall be collected by the secretary 25 and shall be deposited into the State Treasury with 50 percent 26 to be credited to the Public Safety Fund and 50 percent to be 27 credited to the State General Fund. 1

2 "The director secretary shall upon request furnish any person an abstract of the operating record of any person 3 4 subject to the provisions of this chapter, which. The abstract 5 shall also fully designate the motor vehicle, if any, registered in the name of such the person, and, if there shall 6 7 be the person has no record of any convictions of such person 8 of violating any law relating to the operation of a motor 9 vehicle or any injury or damage caused by such the person, the 10 director secretary shall so certify. The director As provided in Section 32-2-8, the secretary shall collect for such 11 abstract the sum of \$5.75 a fee not to exceed fifteen dollars 12 13 (\$15) for the abstract. Notwithstanding the distribution of the fee provided in Section 32-2-8, five dollars and 14 15 seventy-five cents (\$5.75) of the fee shall be deposited into the State Treasury to the credit of the State General Fund and 16 17 the remainder shall be deposited into the State Treasury to 18 the credit of the Public Safety Fund."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
