- Section 1. Section 29-1-23.1 is added to the Code of

- (a) Notwithstanding Section 29-1-23, the Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives may allow a member of the respective body of the Legislature to purchase a chair or a desk used by that member in the respective legislative chamber for his or her personal possession. The secretary and the clerk shall establish the replacement cost in accordance with subsection (b), guidelines for eligibility of members, and any restrictions on the purchase of desks and chairs.
 - (b) The Secretary of the Senate and the Clerk of the House of Representatives may not sell any desk or chair to a member of the Legislature at a cost below the full cost of replacement with a comparable desk or chair of the same quality.
 - (c) At the time a legislative chamber is renovated, the Secretary of the Senate or the Clerk of the House of Representatives, as the case may be, may acquire a chair or desk or both for archival purposes.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
