SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, members of county boards of education are elected for terms of six years.

This bill would propose a local constitutional amendment relating to Butler County to provide that the members of the county board of education shall serve four-year terms of office.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Butler County; to provide that members of the county board of education shall serve four-year terms of office.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

1 PROPOSED AMENDMENT

2 Commencing with the election of members to the
3 Butler County Board of Education in November 2020, members
4 shall serve for terms of four years.

5 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment
6 shall be held in accordance with Section 284.01 of the
7 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section
8 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of
9 Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
10 state.

11 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall
12 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional
13 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the
14 following description of the substance or subject matter of
15 the proposed constitutional amendment:

16 "Relating to Butler County, proposing an amendment
17 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide, commencing
18 with the election of members to the county board of education
19 in November 2020, that members shall be elected to serve for
20 terms of four years.

21 "Proposed by Act _____"

22 This description shall be followed by the following
23 language:
