6 (c) Any individual violating this section shall be 7 guilty of a violation, and upon conviction, shall be punished 8 by a fine of not more than fifty dollars (\$50) for a first 9 offense, nor more than two hundred dollars (\$200) for each 10 subsequent offense.

(d) Nothing in this section shall apply to
individuals operating a flatbed truck and crossing a public
highway in order to continue on a county or municipal road.

14 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its 15 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further 16 17 requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 18 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the 19 20 bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an 21 existing crime.

22 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 23 first day of the third month following its passage and 24 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
