17	regularly furnished to transients for a consideration, in an
18	amount of seven percent of the charge for the room, rooms,
19	lodgings, or accommodations, including the charge for use or

22	levied under this act any rentals or services taxed under
23	Division 1 of Chapter 23 of Title 40, Code of Alabama, 1975.

The tax herein levied shall be collected in the same manner as the state lodgings tax as provided in 4 Chapter 26, Title 40, Code of Alabama, 1975, and the net 5 proceeds, less a reasonable cost of collection not to exceed 6 7 five percent, from the tax shall be paid into the county general fund to be distributed for the construction, 8 9 operation, maintenance, financing and refinancing of the 10 county jail.

11 Section 4. This act shall become effective 12 immediately following its passage and approval by the 13 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
