SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, termination dates are established for enumerated state agencies. The agencies are periodically reviewed by the Alabama Sunset Committee. After the review process is completed, the committee prepares its recommendations for the agencies to the Legislature in the form of sunset bills which either continue, terminate, or continue with modification each agency reviewed.

This bill would provide for the continuance of the Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators until October 1, 2025.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Sunset Law; to continue the existence and functioning of the Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators until October 1, 2025.

1 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

2 Section 1. Pursuant to the Alabama Sunset Law, the  
3 Sunset Committee recommends the continuance of the Board of  
4 Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators until October 1,  
5 2025.

6 Section 2. The existence and functioning of the  
7 Board of Examiners of Nursing Home Administrators, created and  
8 functioning pursuant to Sections 34-20-1 to 34-20-16,  
9 inclusive, Code of Alabama 1975, is continued, and those code  
10 sections are expressly preserved until October 1, 2025.

11 Section 3. The Legislature concurs in the  
12 recommendations of the Sunset Committee as provided in  
13 Sections 1 and 2.

14 Section 4. This act shall become effective  
15 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Governor, or  
16 its otherwise becoming law.
