2 ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to distinctive motor vehicle license 3 plates; to amend Sections 32-6-271 and 32-6-280, Code of 4 5 Alabama 1975; to provide for an annual fee of one dollar for 6 the issuance of distinctive firefighter motor vehicle license plates; and to provide that 50 cents of each dollar collected 7 8 would be deposited into a fund managed by the Alabama Joint 9 Fire Council and used for the purpose of expanding and 10 maintaining the Alabama Firefighter Memorial located in 11 Tuscaloosa, and that the other 50 cents of each dollar 12 collected would be distributed to the Alabama Fire College to 13 be used for training expenses associated with the Firefighter 14 Peer Support program.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Sections 32-6-271 and 32-6-280, Code of Alabama 1975, are amended to read as follows:

"§32-6-271.

19 "(a) A firefighter may, upon application and subject 20 to the provisions of this division, may be issued a 21 distinctive motor vehicle license plate as identification as a 22 firefighter. In addition to the proper numbers, words, and 23 insignias used on the standard license plate issued for motor 24 vehicles, the distinctive plates so issued firefighters shall 25 bear a red Maltese cross emblem on each side to the left and HB77

right of the regular tag numbers. The words "Fire Fighter"

2	should be centered at the bottom of the license plate.
3	"(b) In addition to any other fees provided for by
4	law, an annual additional fee of twenty-five cents (\$.25) <u>one</u>
5	dollar (\$1.00) is added to the cost of the firefighter
6	distinctive license plate provided for in this division <u>,</u>
7	effective January 1, 2022. The annual additional fee collected
8	pursuant to this section shall be distributed by each
9	licensing official to the state Comptroller. The state
10	Comptroller shall distribute the net proceeds monthly <u>as</u>
11	follows:
12	"(1) Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be deposited into a
13	fund managed by the Alabama Joint Fire Council and shall be
14	used for the purpose of expanding and maintaining the Alabama
15	Firefighter Memorial located in Tuscaloosa.
16	"(2) Fifty cents ($\$.50$) shall be distributed to the
17	<u>Alabama</u> Fire College <u>Joint Fire Council to be used for</u>
18	training expenses associated with the Firefighter Peer Support
19	Program."
20	(3) The funds generated by this fee shall be subject
21	to audit from either the Alabama Department of Public
22	Examiners or an independent certified public accountant once
23	every three calendar years effective January 1, 2022.

1 "(a) As used in this section, the following terms
2 shall have the following meanings:

"(1) Professional firefighter means a paid member of
a paid or part-paid fire department of a city, town, county,
or other subdivision of the state, including the chief,
assistant chief, warden, engineer, captain, firemen, and all
other officers and employees of the department who actually
engage in fire fighting or rendering first aid at the scene of
an accident.

"(2) Retired professional firefighter means a 10 11 retired member of a paid or part-paid fire department of a city, town, county, or other subdivision of the state, 12 13 including the chief, assistant chief, warden, engineer, 14 captain, firemen, and all other officers and employees of the 15 department who actually engaged in fire fighting or rendering first aid at the scene of an accident. Notwithstanding any 16 17 other provision of this division, retired professional firefighter includes a retired professional firefighter who is 18 a resident of this state and who has retired from a 19 professional fire department in another state and otherwise 20 21 meets the requirements of this section.

"(b)(1) Notwithstanding Sections 32-6-64, 32-6-67,
and 32-6-68, a retired professional firefighter, upon
application and subject to the provisions of this section, may
be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate as

identification as a retired professional firefighter, and a professional firefighter, upon application and subject to the provisions of this section, may be issued a distinctive motor vehicle license plate as identification as a professional firefighter.

6 "(2) In addition to the proper numbers, words, and insignias used on the standard license plate issued for motor 7 8 vehicles, the distinctive plates so issued for a retired professional firefighter shall have a design created by the 9 10 state association of professional firefighters in coordination 11 with the Mobile Retired Firefighters and Paramedics Association and the Tuscaloosa Retired Firefighters 12 13 Association, and the distinctive license plate so issued for a 14 professional firefighter shall have a design created by the 15 state association of professional firefighters.

16 "(c)(1) The distinctive license plates provided 17 herein shall be approved by the Commissioner of Revenue and 18 shall be issued through the judge of probate, license 19 commissioner, or other license issuing official of the several 20 counties of the state in the same manner as are other motor 21 vehicle license plates and the officers shall be entitled to 22 their regular fees for the service.

"(2) By December 1 of each year, the Firefighters'
Personnel Standards and Education Commission shall submit to
the judge of probate, the license commissioner, or other

1 license issuing official of each county a list of eligible 2 retired professional firefighters retired from paid or part-paid fire departments under this section. The 3 Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission 4 5 shall also add to the list any retired professional 6 firefighter retired from a paid or part-paid fire department 7 in another state who submits proof to the commission of eligibility pursuant to this division. The Firefighters' 8 Personnel Standards and Education Commission shall also submit 9 10 to the judge of probate, the license commissioner, or other 11 license issuing official of each county a list of eligible professional firefighters from paid or part-paid fire 12 13 departments.

14 "(3) Any person who joins a paid or part-paid fire 15 department after December 1 of any year or any person who is 16 omitted from the list prepared as described above in 17 subdivision (2) may obtain a distinctive license plate by presenting to the license issuing official proof of his or her 18 19 membership in a paid or part-paid fire department by means of a certificate signed by the chief of the department on a form 20 21 prescribed by the Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education Commission. 22

"(4) Upon the initial application for a retired
professional firefighter distinctive license plate under this
section, an applicant for a distinctive plate provided herein

in this section shall present to the judge of probate, the 1 2 license commissioner, or other license issuing official of the county, proof of his or her retirement from a fire department 3 that is included on the list provided by the Firefighters' 4 Personnel Standards and Education Commission. Proof of the 5 6 person's retirement from a fire department included on the 7 list from the Firefighters' Personnel Standards and Education 8 Commission is not required for renewal of the distinctive 9 plate.

10 "(5) Upon the applicant submitting proof of his or 11 her identification, the professional firefighter shall be 12 issued the requested number of distinctive license plates upon 13 the payment of the regular fee for license plates, as provided 14 by law, but shall not be required to pay the three dollar (\$3) 15 fee.

16 "(6) Upon the applicant submitting proof of his or 17 her identification, the retired professional firefighter shall 18 be issued the requested number of distinctive license plates 19 upon the payment of the regular license fee for plates, as 20 provided by law, but shall not be required to pay the three 21 dollar (\$3) fee.

"(7) The distinctive license plates so issued shall
be used only upon and for personally owned, private passenger
vehicles, to include station wagons and pick-up trucks,
registered in the name of the retired professional firefighter

or professional firefighter making application therefor, and when so issued to the applicant shall be used upon the vehicle for which issued in lieu of the standard license plates normally issued for the vehicle.

5 "(8) (8)a. In addition to any other fees provided 6 for by law, an annual additional fee of twenty-five cents 7 (\$.25) one dollar (\$1.00) is added to the cost of the retired 8 professional firefighter and the professional firefighter 9 distinctive license plates provided for in this division. The annual additional fee collected pursuant to this section shall 10 11 be, effective January 1, 2022. The annual additional fee collected pursuant to this section shall be distributed by 12 13 each licensing official to the state Comptroller. The state 14 Comptroller shall distribute the net proceeds monthly as follows: 15

16 "a.<u>1. Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be</u> deposited into a 17 fund managed by the Alabama Joint Fire Council and shall be 18 used for the purpose of expanding and maintaining the Alabama 19 Firefighter Memorial located in Tuscaloosa.

"b.2. Fifty cents (\$.50) shall be distributed to the
 Alabama Fire College Joint Fire Council to be used for
 training expenses associated with the Firefighter Peer Support
 Program.

"(9) Anyone who is proven to have either falsely
obtained or certified an individual to obtain a distinctive
retired professional firefighter license plate or a
distinctive professional firefighter license plate shall be
guilty of a Class C misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be
punished according to law.

"(d) Retired professional firefighters distinctive 9 10 license plates as provided by this section shall be prepared 11 and furnished for the licensing year commencing January 1, 2012, and thereafter as is provided by law for the issuance of 12 13 other license plates. Professional firefighters distinctive 14 license plates as provided by this section shall be prepared 15 and furnished for the licensing year commencing January 1, 16 2016, and thereafter as is provided by law for the issuance of 17 other license plates.

18 "(e) The Department of Revenue may promulgate <u>adopt</u>
19 any rules necessary to administer this section."

20 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 21 first day of the third month following its passage and 22 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
