22	administered to a person by a provider records on vaccines
23	administered to all ages, including historical records of
24	vaccinations. The nature of the immunization information
25	contained in this registry shall be determined by rule of the
26	State Board of Health and shall be obtained from clinic
27	records, billing data and information, and vital or any other

records owned and controlled by the state board of	nearth and
the Alabama Medicaid Agency. Medical insurers and p	ublic and
private providers are authorized and encouraged to	provide
information to the registry. In the absence of a	
bi-directional interface with the registry to send	current or
retrieve historical records of vaccination administ	rations,
all providers shall review the registry before a va	ccine is
administered and provide all vaccine data through e	electronic
interface or manual entry in the registry. If the p	rovider is
using a bi-directional electronic interface, the pr	<u>ovider</u>
