PROPOSED AMENDMENT

(a) For purposes of this subdivision, "remote
participation" means simultaneous, interactive participation,
including deliberating and voting, in a legislative committee
meeting or session of either house of the Legislature by
electronic or other technological means by some or all members
of the committee or some or all members of each house who are
not physically present at the meeting or session.

(b) Notwithstanding any other provision of the constitution, during a state of emergency declared by the Legislature or the Governor as provided under existing law, members of the Legislature may participate in committee meetings and sessions of each house by remote participation pursuant to rules adopted by each house of the Legislature.

(c) The rules adopted pursuant to subsection (b) shall ensure that the electronic or other technological means employed for remote participation safeguard the integrity of the legislative process and maintain the deliberative character of the meeting by providing for simultaneous verbal communication and participation among all members.

23 Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment 24 shall be held in accordance with Sections 284 and 285 of the 25 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 26 and 285 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of

Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this
 state.

3 Section 3. The appropriate election official shall 4 assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional 5 amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the 6 following description of the substance or subject matter of 7 the proposed constitutional amendment:
