Amendment 621 of the Constitution of Alabama 16 17 of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the 18 Official Recompilation of the Constitution of 19 Alabama of 1901, as amended, prohibits a general 20 law whose purpose or effect would be to require a 21 new or increased expenditure of local funds from 22 becoming effective with regard to a local 23 governmental entity without enactment by a 2/3 vote 24 unless: it comes within one of a number of 25 specified exceptions; it is approved by the 26 affected entity; or the Legislature appropriates

1funds, or provides a local source of revenue, to2the entity for the purpose.

The purpose or effect of this bill would be 3 to require a new or increased expenditure of local 4 5 funds within the meaning of the amendment. However, the bill does not require approval of a 6 7 local governmental entity or enactment by a 2/3 vote to become effective because it comes within 8 9 one of the specified exceptions contained in the 10 amendment.

16 Relating to crimes and offenses; to amend Section 13A-10-52, Code of Alabama 1975, to revise the criminal 17 18 penalties for violations of fleeing or attempting to elude law enforcement; and in connection therewith would have as its 19 20 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 21 expenditure of local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 22 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the 23 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. 24 25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA: 26 Section 1. Section 13A-10-52, Code of Alabama 1975,

27 is amended to read as follows:

"§13A-10-52. 1 2 "(a) It shall be unlawful for a person to 3 intentionally flee by any means from anyone the person knows to be a law enforcement officer if the person knows the 4 5 officer is attempting to arrest the person. 6 "(b) It shall be unlawful for a person while 7 operating a motor vehicle on a street, road, alley, or highway 8 in this state, to intentionally flee or attempt to elude a law enforcement officer after having received a signal from the 9 10 officer to bring the vehicle to a stop. "(c)(1) A violation of subsection (a) or (b) is a 11 12 Class A misdemeanor unless the. 13 "(2) A violation of subsection (a) or (b) is a Class 14 C felony if the flight or attempt to elude causes an actual 15 death or physical injury to innocent bystanders or third parties, in which case the violation shall be a Class C 16 17 felony. In addition, the any other person. "(d) Upon conviction of subsection (a) or (b), the 18 court shall order the suspension of the driver's license of 19 20 the defendant for a period of not less than six months nor 21 more than two years." 22 Section 2. Although this bill would have as its 23 purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased 24 expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further requirements and application under Amendment 621, now 25 26 appearing as Section 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of

the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, because the

bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an
existing crime.

3 Section 3. This act shall become effective on the 4 first day of the third month following its passage and 5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
