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4 ENROLLED, An Act,

5 Relating to administrative procedure; to amend
6 Section 41-22-7, Code of Alabama 1975, as last amended by Act
7 2019-498 of the 2019 Regular Session, to remove the
8 requirement that the Legislative Services Agency publish the
9 Alabama Administrative Code in loose leaf form; to require the
10 Legislative Services Agency to publish the Alabama
11 Administrative Code and the Alabama Administrative Monthly on
12 the Internet in a format that is viewable by the general
13 public at no subscription charge; and to authorize the
14 administrative procedure secretary of each agency to publish
15 the administrative rules of the agency in a loose leaf form,
16 electronic form, or both.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. Section 41-22-7 of the Code of Alabama
19 1975, as last amended by Act 2019-498 of the 2019 Regular
20 Session, is amended to read as follows:

21 "§41-22-7.

22 "(a) The secretary of an agency shall establish and
23 maintain an official register of rules which shall be
24 compiled, indexed, published in loose-leaf form, electronic
25 form, or both, and kept up to date by the secretary of the

1 agency. This register of rules shall be known as "The (name of
2 the agency) Administrative Code," and it shall be made
3 available, upon request, at cost to all persons for copying
4 and inspection and to those persons who subscribe to the
5 register. Supplementation shall be made as often as is
6 practicable, but at least once every year. The secretary of an
7 agency shall number and renumber rules to conform with a
8 uniform numbering system devised by the Legislative Services
9 Agency, Legal Division.

10 "(b) The secretary of an agency may omit from its
11 administrative code rules that are general in form, but are
12 applicable to only one county or a part thereof. Rules so
13 omitted shall be filed with the secretary, and exclusion from
14 publication shall not affect their validity or effectiveness.
15 The secretary shall publish a compilation of and index to all
16 rules so omitted at least annually.

17 "(c) The secretary of an agency shall make copies of
18 the agency's administrative code available on an annual
19 subscription basis, at cost.

20 "(d) The secretary of an agency shall file with the
21 Legislative Services Agency, Legal Division, not later than 15
22 days after filing with the secretary, all rules or amendments
23 or repeal of rules adopted by the agency. In addition, the
24 secretaries of the Alabama Public Service Commission and the
25 Alabama State Port Authority, respectively, shall file with

1 the Legislative Services Agency, Legal Division, not later
2 than 15 days after filing with the secretary, all rules or
3 amendments or repeal of rules adopted by the commission or
4 authority.

5 "(e) The Legislative Services Agency, Legal
6 Division, shall establish and maintain an official register of
7 rules which shall be so compiled, indexed, published ~~in~~
8 ~~loose-leaf form~~ on the Internet, and kept up to date by the
9 Legislative Services Agency, Legal Division. The register of
10 rules shall be known as the "Alabama Administrative Code" and
11 shall ~~upon request,~~ be made available ~~at cost to all persons~~
12 ~~for inspection and copying or who subscribe thereto~~ to the
13 public in electronic format. Supplementation shall be made as
14 ~~often soon~~ as is practicable, ~~but at least once every year~~
15 following the effective date of each addition, amendment, or
16 repeal of a rule. The Legislative Services Agency, Legal
17 Division, shall devise a uniform numbering system for rules
18 and may renumber rules before publication to conform with the
19 system.

20 "(f) The Legislative Services Agency, Legal
21 Division, shall publish a monthly bulletin entitled the
22 "Alabama Administrative Monthly," which shall contain a
23 statement of either the terms or substance of all rules filed
24 during the preceding month, excluding rules in effect on
25 October 1, 1982, together with other material required by law

1 and such other material the agency or committee determines to
2 be of general interest. The Legislative Services Agency shall
3 publish the Alabama Administrative Monthly on the Internet on
4 a website available to the general public for viewing at no
5 subscription cost.

6 "(g) The Legislative Services Agency, Legal
7 Division, may omit from the Alabama Administrative Monthly and
8 the Alabama Administrative Code rules that are general in
9 form, but are applicable to only one county or a part thereof.
10 Rules so omitted shall be filed with the Legislative Services
11 Agency, Legal Division, and exclusion from publication shall
12 not affect their validity or effectiveness. The Legislative
13 Services Agency, Legal Division, shall publish a compilation
14 of, and index to, all rules so omitted at least annually.

15 "(h) The Legislative Services Agency, Legal
16 Division, shall make copies of the Alabama Administrative Code
17 and copies of the Alabama Administrative Monthly available ~~at~~
18 ~~cost on an annual subscription basis~~ on the Internet.

19 "(i) The Legislative Services Agency, Legal
20 Division, shall charge each agency using the Alabama
21 Administrative Monthly a space rate computed to cover all
22 publishing ~~or printing~~ costs related to the Alabama
23 Administrative Monthly and shall charge each agency a per page
24 rate for each page published in the Alabama Administrative
25 Code to cover costs incurred by the Legislative Services

1 Agency, Legal Division, in publishing the Alabama
2 Administrative Code."

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
4 first day of the third month following its passage and
5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
