SYNOPSIS: This bill would limit a community or technical college from awarding any more than four athletic scholarships for each sport it sponsors to out-of-state recruits.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to education; to limit a community or technical college from awarding any more than four athletic scholarships for each sport it sponsors to out-of-state recruits.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, a community or technical college means a publicly supported two-year school established as a community college, junior college, technical college, or trade school operated under the supervision of the Alabama Community College System.

1 (b) Beginning with the 2022-2023 academic year, a
2 community or technical college shall award no more than four
3 athletic scholarships for each sport the community or
4 technical college sponsors to out-of-state recruits.

5 (c) The Board of Trustees of the Alabama Community
6 College System shall adopt rules to implement and enforce this
7 section.

8 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
9 first day of the third month following its passage and
10 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
