BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 38-3-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"\$38-3-1**.**

- "(a) There is hereby created the Department of Senior Services of the State of Alabama, which shall be under the direction and control of the Commissioner of the Department of Senior Services.
- which that shall consist of 16 members, which and shall advise the commissioner in the administration of the department. The advisory board shall be composed of two members of the Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate; two members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of the House; the Commissioner Secretary of the State Department of Labor or his or her designee, the State Health Officer or his or her designee, and the Commissioner of the State Department of Human Resources or his or her designee, as ex officio members; and nine 10 members to be appointed by the Governor for terms concurrent with the term of the Governor. Of the members appointed by the Governor, one shall be a representative of business, one shall be a representative of

labor, one shall be a representative of the medical 1 2 profession, three shall be representatives of senior citizen 3 organizations, one shall be a representative of an organization serving individuals with disabilities, and the 4 remaining three shall be responsible citizens residents of the 5 state. Upon reappointment, the membership of the board shall 7 be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. The name of 8 any designee to the advisory board of directors authorized by 9 10 this chapter shall be submitted in writing to the Commissioner 11 of the Department of Senior Services." 12 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 13 first day of the third month following its passage and

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
