Relating to the advisory board of directors of the Department of Senior Services; to amend Section 38-3-1 of the Code of Alabama 1975; to allow authorization of a designee to attend meetings on behalf of an ex officio member of the board; to authorize the appointment of an additional board member who would represent an organization serving individuals with disabilities; and to allow the Governor and the Director of Finance to designate an individual to serve in their place on multi-member bodies.

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 38-3-1, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§38-3-1.

"(a) There is hereby created the Department of Senior Services of the State of Alabama, which shall be under the direction and control of the Commissioner of the Department of Senior Services.

"(b) There is created an advisory board of directors which that shall consist of 16 members, which and shall advise the commissioner in the administration of the department. The advisory board shall be composed of two members of the Senate to be appointed by the President of the Senate; two members of the House of Representatives to be appointed by the Speaker of

1	the House; the <del>Commissioner</del> <u>Secretary</u> of the State Department			
2	of Labor <u>or his or her designee</u> , the State Health Officer <u>or</u>			
3	his or her designee, and the Commissioner of the State			
4	Department of Human Resources or his or her designee, as ex			
5	officio members; and $\frac{10}{10}$ members to be appointed by the			
6	Governor for terms concurrent with the term of the Governor.			
7	Of the members appointed by the Governor, one shall be a			
8	representative of business, one shall be a representative of			
9	labor, one shall be a representative of the medical			
10	profession, three shall be representatives of senior citizen			
11	organizations, one shall be a representative of an			
12	organization serving individuals with disabilities, and the			
13	remaining three shall be responsible citizens residents of the			
14	state. Upon reappointment, the membership of the board shall			
15	be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic,			
16	urban/rural, and economic diversity of the state. The name of

13	Section 4. This act shall become effective on the

approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
