(3) When the sheriff is imprisoned. 11 12 (4) In any case in which the sheriff is a party. 13 (5) In any case when he or she is directed by the 14 judge of probate. 15 Section 2. Section 11-5-5 of the Code of Alabama 16 1975, relating to the county coroner serving as sheriff under certain conditions, is repealed. 17
