BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. During a state of emergency declared pursuant to Section 31-9-8, Code of Alabama 1975, in response to an epidemic or outbreak of a disease, a county health officer may not issue any order or directive that relates to the control, prevention, or minimization of the epidemic or outbreak if the State Health Officer, pursuant to his or her authority granted under Title 22, Code of Alabama 1975, has issued any statewide order or directive that relates to the control, prevention, or minimization of the epidemic or outbreak.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
