organization meeting certain criteria established by the

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 34-12-30, Code of Alabama 1975,

is amended to read as follows:

13 "\$34-12-30.

"(a) A State Board of Registration for Foresters is created whose duty it shall be to administer this chapter. The board shall consist of five foresters, who shall be selected and appointed by the Governor of Alabama from among 10 nominees recommended by the Alabama Division of the Society of American Foresters and shall have the qualifications required by Section 34-12-31. Each member of the board shall receive a certificate of his or her appointment from the Governor and before beginning his or her term of office shall file with the Secretary of State his or her written oath of affirmation for the faithful discharge of his or her official duties. The five members of the initial board shall be appointed for terms of

1 one, two, three, four, and five years, respectively, and in 2 making the appointment the Governor shall designate the term for which each of the members is appointed as provided for 3 above. At the expiration of the term of any member of the 5 initial board, the Governor shall, from a list of three 6 nominees recommended by the Alabama Division of the Society of 7 American Foresters and any active state forestry organization 8 meeting criteria established by the board pursuant to 9 subsection (c), shall appoint for a term of five years a 10 registered forester having the qualifications required by 11 Section 34-12-31 to succeed the member whose term on the board is expiring. Nothing contained in this chapter shall prohibit 12 13 any member whose term expires to be reappointed to succeed 14 himself or herself on the board. After March 7, 1990, no 15 member shall serve more than two full consecutive terms of 16 office. If the Governor fails to make appointment in 90 days 17 after expiration of any term, the board shall make the 18 necessary appointment from nominees submitted as hereinabove 19 provided and who meet the qualifications set out by Section 34-12-31. Each member of the board shall hold office until the 20 21 expiration of the term for which such member is appointed or 22 until a successor shall have been duly appointed and shall 23 have qualified.

"(b) The membership of the board shall be inclusive and reflect the racial, gender, geographic, urban/rural, and

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1	economic diversity of the state. The board shall annually
2	report to the Legislature by the second legislative day of
3	each regular session the extent to which the board has
4	complied with the diversity provisions of this subsection.
5	"(c) The board shall adopt rules setting qualifying
6	criteria for active state forestry organizations to
7	participate in the recommendation of nominees for placement
8	for membership on the board pursuant to subsection (a)."
9	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
10	first day of the third month following its passage and
11	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
