Under existing law, when a person is cited 8 SYNOPSIS: for a nonfelony traffic infraction, the arresting 9 10 law enforcement officer issues and files with the 11 court a Uniform Traffic Ticket and Complaint or an 12 approved electronic version of the ticket and 13 serves upon the person a notice to appear. The 14 person may plead guilty by appearing before the 15 court and paying the fine, by signing and mailing 16 the ticket to the court with the cost of the fine, 17 or by paying the amount of the fine electronically. 18 The person may also plead not guilty by appearing 19 before the court as provided in the notice to 20 appear.

This bill would provide that if a person who is issued a citation for a nonfelony traffic infraction appears before a court as provided in the notice to appear and pleads not guilty, and the law enforcement officer who issued the citation fails to appear before the court, the court is
