or rule relating to the operation or use of motor vehicles or
 other vehicles or the use of streets and highways by
 pedestrians.

4 (b) A county, municipal, or state law enforcement
5 agency may not do either of the following:

6 (1) Require a law enforcement officer to issue a 7 predetermined or specified amount of any type or combination 8 of types of citations for traffic infractions within a 9 specified time period.

10 (2) Provide any kind of incentive or reward to a law
 11 enforcement officer for issuing any type or combination of
 12 types of citations for traffic infractions.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
