26	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 17-9-50, Code of Alabama 1975, is
amended to read as follows:

"§17-9-50.

"Except as electors and individuals to assist them 4 5 are admitted to vote and persons to assist them as herein 6 provided, and except for the judge of probate, the sheriff, or 7 his or her deputy, the precinct election officials, and watchers, no person individual shall be permitted within 30 8 feet of the door of the building of the polling place. For 9 10 purposes of this section, 30 feet shall be measured from the door of the building in which voting machines are located." 11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 12

first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
