6 ENROLLED, An Act,

7 Relating to Elmore County; authorizing under certain
8 conditions the sale of draft or keg beer by properly licensed
9 retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control
10 Board in the county; and to authorize additional permit fees.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

12 Section 1. The Elmore County Commission, by
13 resolution of the commission, may authorize, regulate, and
14 permit the sale and distribution of draft or keg beer in any
15 size container for on-premises and off-premises consumption by
16 properly licensed retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic
17 Beverage Control Board in the unincorporated areas of Elmore
18 County and within the corporate limits of any municipality in
19 the county upon approval of the municipal governing body of
20 the municipality. The Elmore County Commission may set and
21 charge an additional fee for a permit to sell draft or keg
22 beer. Any proceeds from the fees shall be deposited in the
23 county general fund.

24 Section 2. Any municipality in Elmore County, by
25 ordinance, may authorize, regulate, and permit the sale and

1 distribution of draft or keg beer in any size container for
2 on-premises and off-premises consumption by properly licensed
3 retail licensees of the Alabama Alcoholic Beverage Control
4 Board in the corporate limits of the municipality. The
5 municipality may set and charge an additional fee for a permit
6 to sell draft or keg beer. Any proceeds from the fees shall be
7 deposited in the municipal general fund. Any action by the
8 municipality under this section shall supersede any prior
9 approval related to the sale of distribution of draft or keg
10 beer under Section 1.

11 Section 3. The provisions of this act are cumulative
12 and supplementary and shall not be construed to repeal or
13 supersede any laws or parts of laws not directly inconsistent
14 herewith.

15 Section 4. This act shall become effective
16 immediately following its passage and approval by the
17 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
