Relating to energy services; to provide that no governmental entity may prohibit a person or entity from using utility services from a provider that is capable of providing service and is otherwise authorized to do business in this state.

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

9 Section 1. (a) For the purposes of this section, the 10 following terms shall have the following meanings:

(1) GOVERNMENTAL ENTITY. The state or any political subdivision thereof, or any executive or legislative department, unit, agency, board, commission, or authority of the state, or any political subdivision, or any public corporation, authority, agency, board, commission, or other governmental entity controlled by the state or by any political subdivision of the state.

18 (2) POLICY. Any requirement or prohibition contained 19 in an ordinance, resolution, regulation, code, proclamation or 20 any other requirement adopted by a governmental entity that is 21 on its face enforceable or intended to be enforced or any 22 practice or mandate undertaken in pursuance thereof by a 23 governmental entity against any person, entity, or corporation 24 or other governmental entity providing utility energy service. 1 (3) UTILITY ENERGY SERVICE. The retail or wholesale 2 sale or provision of energy service, whether in the form of 3 electricity, natural gas, fuel oil, propane, methane, ethanol, 4 or other fuel, by a person, firm, or corporation engaged in 5 the business of providing such service.

6 (b) No governmental entity or its governing body, 7 officer, agent, or employee thereof, shall adopt, proclaim, or 8 enforce any policy that prohibits, or has the effect of 9 prohibiting, the provision or purchase of utility energy 10 service or the connection or reconnection of piping or wiring, 11 equipment, motor, or appliances used or usable for the purpose 12 of utilizing any utility energy service to or by any person 13 for retail or wholesale use based upon the form or type of 14 utility energy service, source of energy therefor, or fuel used therefor. 15

16 (c) Nothing in this section shall limit the ability 17 of a governmental entity to select, install, or operate 18 utility energy services of such type as it may choose for 19 properties owned or operated by or for the benefit of the 20 governmental entity.

21 (d) This section does not apply to the provision or
22 purchase of utility energy service by any utility or utility
23 system established and operated by a municipality under
24 Chapter 50 of Title 11, Code of Alabama 1975.

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1	(2) UTILITY SERVICE. Electrical, natural gas, or			
2	propane gas service provided to an end user.			
3	Section 2. Except as otherwise provided in this act,			
4	no governmental entity may adopt an ordinance, resolution,			
5	regulation, or policy that prohibits, or has the effect of			
6	restricting, a person's or entity's ability to use a utility			
7	service of a provider that is authorized to do business in			
8	this state.			
9	Section 3. Nothing in this act shall be construed as			
10	affecting a governmental entity's authority to do the			
11	following:			
12	(1) Exercise existing police powers to review and			
13	approve an application before issuing building permits or to			
14	otherwise enforce building, fire, and other public safety			
15	codes or subdivision regulations. Provided, however, no			
16	governmental entity may deny a building permit or subdivision			
17	regulation application based solely on the type of utility			
18	service proposed for the project.			
19	(2) License or permit a provider of a utility			
20	service, or regulate the use of rights-of-way by a provider of			
21	a utility service, in accordance with existing law. Provided,			
22	however, no governmental entity may deny a license or permit			
23	based solely on the type of utility service provided by the			
24	provider.			

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1	(3) Regulate the permitting, safe handling, storage,			
2	or use of propane gas.			
3	(e) Section 4. Nothing in this section <u>act</u> shall be			
4	deemed to affect the rules of the Alabama Public Service			
5	Commission adopted in accordance with its powers under Title			
6	37, Code of Alabama 1975. This section does not limit or			
7	restrict the power or authority of a utility to take action			
8	pursuant to any rules of the commission or the practices			
9	established under the rules.			
10	Section 5. Nothing in this act shall be deemed to			
11	amend, alter, modify, or in any way affect Chapter 14 of Title			
12	<u>37, Code of Alabama 1975.</u>			
13	Section 6. This act shall become effective on the			
14	first day of the third month following its passage and			
15	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
