Relating to House and Senate security; to amend Section 29-4-4, Code of Alabama 1975, to further provide for the security of the Alabama State House; and to require the Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency, in consultation with the Legislative Council, to provide security of the perimeter and entry points of the State House.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 29-4-4, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

12 "\$29-4-4.

- "(a) Security Unless provided otherwise by law or applicable legislative rule or policy, security personnel employed by the House of Representatives and the Senate shall be responsible for the security of the third, fourth, fifth, sixth, seventh, and eighth floors of the Alabama State House, such other areas within the Alabama State House as are occupied or used by the Legislature, and such other additional areas outside the Alabama State House in accordance with Section 29-1-19.
- "(b) The security officers employed under this chapter shall have the powers of peace officers in this state and may exercise those powers only in the areas designated in subsection (a).

Τ	(C) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency, In		
2	coordination with the Legislative Council, shall be		
3	responsible for the security of the perimeter and points of		
4	entry to the Alabama State House as prescribed by the		
5	Legislative Council.		
6	"(d)(1) Every department, agency, and bureau of the		
7	State of Alabama shall assist in any manner requested by the		
8	Legislature in assuring the security of the areas of the

11	section shall apply to any convening of the Legislature		
12	outside of the Capitol or away from the Alabama State House in
