ENROLLED, An Act,

To propose an amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, relating to Walker County, to provide that the judge of probate would be required to be an attorney licensed in this state.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. The following amendment to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become valid as a part of the Constitution when all requirements of this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

The Judge of Probate of Walker County shall be an attorney licensed in this state effective upon the election or appointment of any judge of probate after ratification of this amendment.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held in accordance with Section 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 284.01 of the Official ReCompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.

Section 3. The appropriate election official shall assign a ballot number for the proposed constitutional amendment on the election ballot and shall set forth the

1 following description of the substance or subject matter of
2 the proposed constitutional amendment:

3 "Relating to Walker County, proposing an amendment
4 to the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, to provide that the
5 Judge of Probate of Walker County would be required to be an
6 attorney licensed in this state.
