17	Section 1. Section 34-21A-10 of the Code of Alabama
18	1975, is amended to read as follows:

20	"(a) The licensing requirements of this chapter
21	shall not apply to owners of property for the purpose of
22	installing, cleaning, servicing, or maintaining an onsite
23	sewage system on their own property with a one-family or
24	two-family residence used as their primary residence so long
25	as the owners of the property with an onsite sewage system
26	complete all installation, cleaning, servicing, or maintenance
27	themselves, without help, at their primary residence.

1	"(b) The board shall not license or regulate any of	
2	the following:	
3	"(1) An individual or entity that distributes septic	
4	tanks or conventional or engineered onsite sewage systems or	
5	onsite wastewater systems.	
6	"(2) An owner of multiple wastewater systems, or a	
7	system that is part of a group of wastewater systems under	
8	common ownership, with one or more of those systems having a	
9	design flow of 15,000 GPD or greater.	
10	"(3) A general contractor licensed by the State	
11	Licensing Board for General Contractors, with a municipal and	
12	utility endorsement, while installing or maintaining	
13	wastewater systems as described in subdivision (2)."	
14	Section 2. This act shall become effective on the	
15	first day of the third month following its passage and	
16	approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
