Section 1. Section 36-3-4 of the Code of Alabama

1975, is amended to read as follows:

4 "\$36-3-4.

"(a) The sheriff, for the term of office of a sheriff serving on the effective date of the act adding this language; one coroner; members of county commissions, one county treasurer, when elective; and one constable for each election precinct, except when the office of constable has been abolished, shall hold their respective offices for the term of four years from the first Monday after the second Tuesday of January next after their election and until their successors are elected and qualified, except as provided in subsection subsections (b) and (c) hereof.

"(b) Beginning with the next term of office for each county commissioner, such term shall expire six days next following the day of the general election at which the successor to that office is elected. Thereafter each such county commissioner shall hold his respective office from 12:01 A.M. of the seventh day next following his election and until his successor is elected and qualified. Each county commissioner shall serve a term as provided for in Section 11-3-1.

"(c) Beginning with the next term of office for each sheriff, the term of the sheriff shall expire fourteen days after the day of the general election at which the successor to that office is elected. Thereafter, each sheriff shall hold

1	his or her respective office from 12:01 a.m. of the fifteenth
2	day after election and until his or her successor is elected
3	and qualified."
4	Section 2. This act shall become effective
5	immediately following its passage and approval by the
6	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
