SYNOPSIS: This bill would prohibit any athletic association that imposes athletic eligibility rules on public K-12 student athletes, without certain procedures for reviewing or appealing official rulings of the association relating to those rules, from using any facility in the state that receives state funds.

A BILL
TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

Relating to public K-12 student athletes; to prohibit any athletic association that imposes athletic eligibility rules on students, without certain procedures for reviewing or appealing official rulings regarding eligibility, from using state funded facilities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Any athletic association that imposes athletic eligibility rules on public K-12 student athletes,

1 without procedures for reviewing or appealing official rulings
2 of the association for at least a three-year period after the
3 eligibility ruling is made, shall be prohibited from using any
4 facility in the state that receives state funds.

5 Section 2. This act shall become effective
6 immediately following its passage and approval by the
7 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
