7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

8 Section 1. The following amendment to the 9 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, is proposed and shall become 10 valid as a part of the constitution when all requirements of 11 this act are fulfilled:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

Beginning with the 2024 cycle, the Cullman County Superintendent of Education shall be elected for a four-year term by the qualified electors of the county zoned for the county school system, and the Legislature, by local law, may provide further for the election, qualifications, and powers of the county superintendent of education.

Section 2. An election upon the proposed amendment shall be held at the General Election in 2022, in accordance with Sections 284 and 284.01 of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Sections 284 and 284.01 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended, and the election laws of this state.
