ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Lamar County; to provide law enforcement powers for a community corrections officer in certain circumstances.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Upon successfully completing the minimum standards of training and other requirements for law enforcement officers of the Peace Officers' Standards and Training Commission, a community corrections officer employed by the Community Punishment and Corrections Authority of the 24th Judicial Circuit, operating in Lamar County, shall have the same law enforcement powers, including powers of arrest, as granted to law enforcement officers of this state.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
