SYNOPSIS: Existing law provides for the membership of the Alabama Justice Information Commission, which includes a voting section and an advisory section.

This bill would add two additional members to the voting section of the commission.

A BILL  
TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

Relating to the Alabama Justice Information Commission; to amend Section 41-9-592, Code of Alabama 1975, to increase the membership of the voting section of the commission.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Section 41-9-592, Code of Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

"§41-9-592.

"(a) The commission shall be composed of two sections.

1                   "(b) The voting section shall include all of the  
2 following:

3                   "(1) The Secretary of the Alabama State Law  
4 Enforcement Agency.

5                   "(2) The Attorney General.

6                   "(3) The Chair of the Board of Pardons and Paroles.

7                   "(4) The Commissioner of the Department of  
8 Corrections.

9                   "(5) The President of the Alabama Sheriffs  
10 Association.

11                   "(6) The President of the Alabama Association of  
12 Chiefs of Police.

13                   "(7) The Director of the Law Enforcement and Traffic  
14 Safety Division within the Alabama Department of Economic and  
15 Community Affairs.

16                   "(8) The President of the Alabama District Attorneys  
17 Association.

18                   "(9) The President of the Alabama Circuit ~~Clerks~~  
19 Clerks Association.

20                   "(10) The Chief Justice of the Alabama Supreme  
21 Court.

22                   "(11) The President of the Alabama District Judges'  
23 Association.

24                   "(12) The President of the Alabama Circuit Judges'  
25 Association.

26                   "(13) The Alabama Secretary of Information  
27 Technology.

1                   "(14) A judge of probate appointed by the President  
2 of the Alabama Probate Judges Association.

3                   "(15) A municipal judge appointed by the President  
4 of the Alabama Municipal Judges Association.

5                   "(c) The advisory section shall include:

6                   "(1) The presiding officer of the Alabama Senate.

7                   "(2) The Speaker of the Alabama House of  
8 Representatives.

9                   "(3) The President of the Association of County  
10 Commissions of Alabama.

11                   "(4) The President of the Alabama League of  
12 Municipalities.

13                   "(5) The Administrative Director of Courts.

14                   "(6) The Executive Director of the Alabama Peace  
15 Officers' Standards and Training Commission.

16                   "(7) A citizen of the State of Alabama, to be  
17 appointed by the Governor.

18                   "(d) Any member, except the citizen appointee, may  
19 designate in writing a designee based upon qualifications and  
20 with a view of continuity of representation and attendance at  
21 the commission meetings.

22                   "(e) No person or individual shall continue to serve  
23 on the commission when he or she no longer officially  
24 represents the function or serves in the capacity enumerated  
25 in this section as a member to which he or she was elected or  
26 appointed."

1                   Section 2. This act shall become effective  
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the  
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
