19	AN ACT

21	Relating to the Alabama Board of Cosmetology and
22	Barbering; to amend Section 34-7B-16, Code of Alabama 1975, to
23	allow a sponsoring licensee to train up to three registered
24	apprentices at one time.
25	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:
26	Section 1. Section 34-7B-16, Code of Alabama 1975,
27	is amended to read as follows:

"§34-7B-16. 1 2 "(a) No person may be registered as an apprentice in a shop unless he or she satisfies all of the following 3 qualifications: 4 5 "(1) Is at least 16 years old. "(2) Has successfully completed at least 10 grades 6 7 in secondary school, or the equivalent. "(3) Has paid the applicable registration fee. 8 9 "(b) Before an apprentice begins work under this 10 chapter, the sponsor, on behalf of a potential apprentice, shall request and obtain an apprenticeship work permit from 11 the board. 12 13 "(c) An apprentice may train in a licensed shop under a current licensee who has been licensed for at least 14 15 five years in the appropriate field. A sponsor may train up to three apprentices in one shop at the same time, and the board 16 shall be immediately notified of any change in apprentice 17 18 sponsorship. "(d) Within 120 days after an apprentice completes 19 20 the required hours and training, the sponsor shall certify a 21 record of completion for the apprentice to the board. 22 "(e) A sponsor who fails to certify apprentice 23 completion to the board in a timely manner shall be in 24 violation of board rules and may be subject to a fine by the 25 board. "(f) If an apprentice does not receive his or her 26 license within two years after certification of completion of 27

training, the board may require the apprentice to complete additional hours of training before applying or reapplying for licensure.

4 "(g) No person who holds a current license in
5 another state shall be issued an apprentice permit for the
6 same type of license."

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
first day of the third month following its passage and
approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
