BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) The Alabama State Law Enforcement Agency (ALEA) shall create a statewide database of residents who have been issued a pistol permit.

- (b) The sheriff of each county of the state shall provide to ALEA information regarding each pistol permit issued by it. ALEA shall specify the format in which and the frequency with which the information shall be submitted.
- (c) After the effective date of this act, the sheriff of the county shall require any person seeking a pistol permit to provide his or her driver's license number if he or she is a licensed driver. The database shall reference the driver's license number of each licensed driver who is issued a pistol permit.
- (d) Any state, county, municipal, or university law enforcement agency may utilize the database upon its creation.
- (e) ALEA may promulgate rules necessary to provide for the compilation of information and creation of the database.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
