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8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, local boards of
9 education are not required to compensate a person
10 employed as an athletic coach pursuant to the State
11 Minimum Salary Schedule unless the person is also
12 employed as a teacher.

13 This bill would limit the total annual
14 compensation paid by a local board of education to
15 a high school athletic coach to 75 percent of the
16 total annual compensation paid to the high school
17 principal.

23 Relating to public K-12 education; to limit the
24 total annual compensation paid by a local board of education
25 to a high school athletic coach to 75 percent of the total
26 annual compensation paid to the high school principal.

27 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

1 Section 1. Commencing with the 2017-2018 school
2 year, the total annual compensation paid to a high school
3 athletic coach by an employing local board of education may
4 not exceed 75 percent of the total annual compensation paid by
5 the local board of education to the principal employed at the
6 same high school. This section does not apply to a high school
7 athletic coach who is also employed as a teacher at the high
8 school.

9 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
10 first day of the third month following its passage and
11 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
