Relating to fire safety; to prohibit the release of 3 4 sky lanterns under certain conditions; to provide penalties; and in connection therewith would have as its purpose or 5 6 effect the requirement of a new or increased expenditure of 7 local funds within the meaning of Amendment 621 of the 8 Constitution of Alabama of 1901, now appearing as Section 9 111.05 of the Official Recompilation of the Constitution of Alabama of 1901, as amended. 10

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) For the purpose of this section, a
"sky lantern" means an unmanned self-contained free-floating
luminary device requiring an open flame underneath, such as a
candle, for propulsion.

(b) It shall be unlawful to possess, sell at retail,
 offer to sell at retail, distribute, or give away a sky
 lantern in this state.

(a) As used in this section, the following words
 have the following meanings:

(1) PUBLIC GATHERING. The presence of more than 500
 members of the public in an outdoor place for the purpose of
 attending a sporting contest, auto race, concert, festival,
 political rally, parade, or similar event.

1	(2) SKY LANTERN. An unmanned self-contained		
2	free-floating luminary device requiring an open flame		
3	underneath, such as a candle, for propulsion.		
4	(b) It is unlawful to release a sky lantern within		
5	500 yards of a public gathering.		
6	(c) A violation of this section is a criminal		
7	violation punishable pursuant to Section 13A-5-12, Code of		
8	Alabama 1975.		
9	Section 2. Although this bill would have as its		
10	purpose or effect the requirement of a new or increased		
11	expenditure of local funds, the bill is excluded from further		
12	requirements and application under Amendment 621 because the		
13	bill defines a new crime or amends the definition of an		
14	existing crime.		
15	Section 3. This act shall become effective on the		
16	first day of the third month <u>immediately</u> following its passage		
17	and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
