24	is authorized in dry counties containing at least one wet
25	municipality, provided the manufacturer is licensed by the
26	Alcoholic Beverage Control Board as provided in Section
27	28-3A-6, Code of Alabama 1975, and complies with all

1 applicable laws and rules pertaining to manufacturer 2 licensees.

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the 4 first day of the third month following its passage and 5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
