20	Section 1. This act shall apply only to Henry
21	County.
22	Section 2. (a) Commencing the first day of the month
23	following the effective date of this act, the Revenue
24	Commissioner of Henry County shall receive an annual expense
25	allowance of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) payable in equal
26	monthly installments. This expense allowance shall be in
27	addition to all other compensation or benefits granted to the

revenue commissioner, including, the compensation provided in Section 45-34-240, Code of Alabama 1975.

- (b) Effective beginning the next term of office, the annual salary of the Revenue Commissioner of Henry County shall be increased by five thousand dollars (\$5,000) and the expense allowance provided for in subsection (a) shall be null and void.
- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, in addition to any other compensation provided to the revenue commissioner, the revenue commissioner shall continue to receive any cost-of-living or other salary increases granted by the county commission to other elected officials in the county.

Section 3. The revenue commissioner shall combine all budgetary operations and functions of the office of the revenue commissioner that were previously divided into the budgetary operations and functions of the tax assessor and the budgetary operations and functions of the tax collector. The expenses of the office shall be financed on a pro rata basis and allocated in the same manner that the salary of the revenue commissioner is paid pursuant to Section 40-6A-2, Code of Alabama 1975. Any funds retained as a result of the combining of budgetary operations and functions pursuant to this section shall be used solely for the operation of the office of the revenue commissioner subject to approval of the budget for the office by the county commission in the same manner as the budget is currently approved.

Section 4. This act shall become effective immediately following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
