BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. Any individual who volunteers without compensation to provide temporary care under the direction of a primary home caregiver for an individual who has a disability or a chronic illness, and who, in good faith, performs the care without compensation for goods or services shall not be liable for any civil damages as a result of any act or omission by the volunteer rendering the care or as a result of any act or failure to act to provide or arrange for care for the individual with a disability or a chronic illness, unless the act or omission causing the damages was the result of willful or wanton misconduct by the volunteer caregiver.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first day of the third month following its passage and approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
