ENROLLED, An Act,

Relating to Covington County; to require future members of the county board of education to reside within, and be elected by the qualified electors of the county who reside within, that portion of the county outside of the corporate limits of any city in the county served by a separate city board of education.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

Section 1. (a) Commencing with the next term of office, each member of the Covington County Board of Education, at the time of qualifying for office and during the entire term of office, shall reside within that portion of the county lying outside of the corporate limits of any city in the county served by a separate city board of education, and shall be elected by the qualified electors who reside within that portion of the county.

(b) Nothing in this section shall affect the unexpired term of any member serving on the board on the effective date of this section.

(c) The appropriate election officials shall conduct elections of members of the Covington County Board of Education in conformity with this section.

1 Section 2. This act shall become effective
2 immediately following its passage and approval by the
3 Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
