8 SYNOPSIS: Under existing law, an elector may choose
9 which party's primary and primary runoff elections
10 to vote in.

11 This bill would prohibit a voter from voting
12 in a primary runoff election unless the voter voted
13 in the preceding primary election of the party for
14 which the runoff election is being held.

20 Relating to primary elections; to prohibit a voter
21 from voting in a primary runoff election unless the voter
22 voted in the preceding primary election of the party for which
23 the runoff election is being held; and to require the
24 Secretary of State to promulgate rules.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

26 Section 1. (a) An elector may vote in a primary
27 runoff election only if he or she voted in the preceding

1 primary election of the same political party for which the
2 runoff election is being held.

3 (b) The Secretary of State shall promulgate rules to
4 implement this section that shall include, but not be limited
5 to, procedures for making a list of who voted in each party
6 primary available to each precinct election official working
7 the polls during a runoff election.

8 (c) A precinct election official or member of the
9 appointing board may not be held responsible for allowing or
10 refusing to allow a voter to cast a ballot in a particular
11 runoff election if he or she acts in good faith compliance
12 with this section or the rules promulgated pursuant to this
13 section.

14 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
15 first day of the third month following its passage and
16 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
