10 TO BE ENTITLED
11 AN ACT
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13 Relating to Franklin County; to amend Section
14 45-30A-50.03 of the Code of Alabama 1975, to authorize the
15 city council to set the compensation of the civil service
16 board.

17 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

18 Section 1. Section 45-30A-50.03 of the Code of
19 Alabama 1975, is amended to read as follows:

20 "§45-30A-50.03.

21 "The personnel program established by this part
22 shall be administered by the board. The board shall consist of
23 five members who are residents of the city and who shall be
24 appointed by the governing body. No member of the board shall
25 be employed by or be an official of the city, nor hold any
26 elective public office. The composition of the board shall be
27 designated as Place No. 1, Place No. 2, Place No. 3, Place No.

1 4, and Place No. 5. The person appointed as a member of the
2 board in Place No. 1 shall serve a term of two years; the
3 person so appointed for Place No. 2 shall serve a term of four
4 years; the person appointed for Place No. 3 shall serve a term
5 of six years. The initial person appointed as a member of the
6 board in Place No. 4 shall serve a term of four years; and the
7 person appointed for Place No. 5 shall serve a term of six
8 years. Thereafter each term shall be for a period of six
9 years. Vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled for
10 the balance of the term by governing bodies. Members of the
11 board shall receive ~~two hundred dollars (\$200) per~~
12 compensation each month for their services ~~to~~ on the board in
13 an amount to be set by the city council. Members shall be
14 entitled to receive their reasonable and necessary expenses
15 incurred in the performance of board business and all such
16 compensation and expenses shall be paid out of the general
17 fund of the city. The board shall elect from its own members a
18 chair, a vice chair, and a secretary-treasurer. The board
19 shall meet as often as necessary to carry out the purpose of
20 this part, but shall meet at least once each quarter, however,
21 the governing body shall have the right to control the
22 appropriations to the board and to regulate the expenses of
23 the board as it deems necessary. A majority of the members of
24 the board shall be necessary to constitute a quorum for the
25 transaction of business and no action shall be taken without
26 the affirmative vote of a majority of the quorum present at a
27 meeting. The board, with the approval of the governing body

1 shall have the right to engage such full- or part-time
2 personnel as shall be necessary to carry out this part."

3 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
4 first day of the third month following its passage and
5 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
