10 TO BE ENTITLED

13 Relating to St. Clair County; to amend Section 1 of
14 Act 84-452, 1984 Regular Session (Acts 1984, p. 1060), as
15 amended by Act 2001-507, 2001 Regular Session (Acts 2001, p.
16 900), and Act 2001-958, 2001 Third Special Session (Acts 2001,
17 p. 826), relating to the St. Clair County Board of Education,
18 to provide further for the boundaries of the five districts
19 from which the district members of the board are elected.

20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF ALABAMA:

21 Section 1. Section 1 of Act 84-452, 1984 Regular
22 Session (Acts 1984, p. 1060), as amended by Act 2001-507, 2001
23 Regular Session (Acts 2001, p. 900), and Act 2001-958, 2001
24 Third Special Session (Acts 2001, p. 826), is amended to read
25 as follows:

26 "Section 1. (a) The St. Clair County Board of
27 Education shall be composed of seven members. One member shall

1 be elected from each of the five single-member districts
2 established by this amendatory act, by a majority of the
3 qualified electors of the county at-large voting in the
4 election, and two at-large members shall be elected by a
5 majority of the qualified electors of the county at-large
6 voting in the election. The election shall be conducted and
7 the members shall take office in the same time and in the same
8 manner as currently provided.

9 "(b) The boundaries of the five single-member board
10 of education districts shall be the attendance zones for the
11 following school districts as drawn from time to time by the
12 board:

13 "(1) The Ashville-Steele District.

14 "(2) The Moody District.

15 "(3) The Odenville District.

16 "(4) The Ragland-Coal City District.

17 "(5) The Springville District.

18 "(c) (1) A candidate for election as a district
19 member of the board shall be a resident of the single-member
20 district which he or she seeks to represent on the board for
21 at least 90 consecutive days immediately preceding the
22 deadline date for qualifying as a candidate, and shall reside
23 in that district during the entire term of office.

24 "(2) A candidate for election as an at-large member
25 of the board shall be a resident of the county for at least 90
26 consecutive days immediately preceding the deadline date for

1 qualifying as a candidate, and shall reside in the county
2 during the entire term of office.

3 "(d) A member appointed to fill a vacancy on the
4 board shall be a resident of the county, and a resident of the
5 district of the vacating member, where applicable.

6 "(e) If the boundaries of a district change, or if
7 redistricting places an incumbent district board member
8 outside of his or her district, the member shall nevertheless
9 continue to serve the remainder of the term to which he or she
10 was elected."

11 Section 2. This act shall become effective on the
12 first day of the third month following its passage and
13 approval by the Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
