25	Commence at an existing railroad spike at the

North 00 degrees 12 minutes 05 seconds East a distance of 132.51 feet from an existing TVA Monument No. 77, thence along Snake Road, North 89 degrees 27 minutes 32 seconds East a distance of 159.97 feet to a point; thence South 20 feet more or less to the South right of way of Snake Road, which said point being the Point of True Beginning of the tract herein described,

Thence from the Point of True Beginning continue
North 89 degrees 27 minutes 32 seconds East along the South
right of way of said Snake Road a distance of 1143.59 feet to
