24	<del>office, the</del> <u>The</u> Butler County Commission shall be composed of
25	five members, elected from single-member districts one through
26	five, inclusive, by the qualified voters residing within each
27	district. The five districts shall be apportioned as provided

1	by law. Each Unless otherwise provided by general law, each
2	commissioner shall reside in the district he or she represents
3	at the time of qualifying for office and during his or her
4	tenure. For the purposes of establishing staggered terms for
5	the members of the county commission, the members of the
6	commission elected to represent districts two and three
7	elected at the general election in 2020 shall serve a term of
8	two years, and beginning with the general election in 2022 and
9	each subsequent general election thereafter, shall serve a
10	term of four years."
11	Section 2. This act shall become effective
12	immediately following its passage and approval by the
13	Governor, or its otherwise becoming law.
